SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

765 ILCS 1025/15 from Ch. 141, par. 115 765 ILCS 1025/20 from Ch. 141, par. 120

Amends the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act. Provides that interest earned on property held in the unclaimed property trust fund or the State pensions fund may be paid to the owner, at the discretion of the State Treasurer. Provides that if a claim for unclaimed property is allowed, the Treasurer may (now, shall) deduct \$20 or less to cover expenses. Provides that the State Treasurer shall pay the allowed claim as soon as practicable (now, forthwith).

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property
- 5 Act is amended by changing Sections 15 and 20 as follows:
- (765 ILCS 1025/15) (from Ch. 141, par. 115) 6
- 7 Sec. 15. When property is paid or delivered to the State
- Treasurer under this Act, the owner is not entitled to receive 8
- income or other increments accruing thereafter, except that 9
- income accruing on unliquidated stock and mutual funds after 10
- July 1, 1993, and interest earned on property held in the 11
- unclaimed property trust fund or the State pensions fund may be 12
- paid to the owner at the discretion of the State Treasurer. 13

- (a) The State Treasurer shall consider any claim filed 17
- 18 under this Act and may, in his discretion, hold a hearing and
- receive evidence concerning it. Such hearing shall be conducted 19
- by the State Treasurer or by a hearing officer designated by 20
- 21 him. No hearings shall be held if the payment of the claim is
- a court, if the claimant is 22 ordered by under court
- jurisdiction, or if the claim is paid under Article XXV of the 23
- 24 Probate Act of 1975. The State Treasurer or hearing officer
- shall prepare a finding and a decision in writing on each
- hearing, stating the substance of any evidence heard by him, 26

- filed pursuant to this Act shall be considered and a finding and decision shall be issued by the Office of the State Treasurer in a timely and expeditious manner.
 - (b) If the claim is allowed, the State Treasurer may deduct and after deducting an amount not to exceed \$20 to cover the cost of notice publication and related clerical expenses. The 7 the State Treasurer shall make payment to the claimant as soon as practicable forthwith.
 - (c) In order to carry out the purpose of this Act, no person or company shall be entitled to a fee for discovering presumptively abandoned property until it has been in the custody of the Unclaimed Property Division of the Office of the State Treasurer for at least 24 months. Fees for discovering property that has been in the custody of that division for more than 24 months shall be limited to not more than 10% of the amount collected.
 - (d) A person or company attempting to collect a contingent fee for discovering, on behalf of an owner, presumptively abandoned property must be licensed as a private detective pursuant to the Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private Security, and Locksmith Act of 1993.
- 22 (e) This Section shall not apply to the fees of an attorney 23 at law duly appointed to practice in a state of the United 24 States who is employed by a claimant with regard to probate 25 matters on a contractual basis.
