7	Sec. 10.09–5. Standards for an energy code. To adopt rules $_{ au}$
8	by January 1, 2004, implementing a statewide energy code for
9	the construction or repair of State facilities described in
10	Section 4.01. The energy code adopted by the Board shall
11	incorporate standards promulgated by the American Society of
12	Heating, Refrigerating and Air-conditioning Engineers, Inc.,
13	(ASHRAE). In proposing rules, the Board shall consult with the
14	Department of Commerce and <u>Economic Opportunity</u> Community
15	Affairs.

17	Section 10. The Energy Efficient Commercial Building Act is
18	amended by changing Section 10 as follows:
19	(20 ILCS 3125/10)
20	Sec. 10. Definitions.
21	"Board" means the Capital Development Board.
22	"Code" means the <u>latest published edition of the</u>

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International Code Council's International Energy Conservation
Code, excluding published supplements but including 2000
International Energy Conservation Code, the ASHRAE 90.1-1999
Standard, which is included within that Code, the 2001
supplement to that Code, and the adaptations to the Code that
are made by the Board.

7 "Commercial building" means any building except a building8 that is a residential building, as defined in this Section.

9 "Department" means the Department of Commerce and Economic10 Opportunity.

11 "Municipality" means any city, village, or incorporated 12 town.

"Residential building" means (i) a detached one-family or 2-family dwelling or (ii) any building that is 3 stories or less in height above grade that contains multiple dwelling units, in which the occupants reside on a primarily permanent basis, such as a townhouse, a row house, an apartment house, a convent, a monastery, a rectory, a fraternity or sorority house, a dormitory, and a rooming house.
