Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 40. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof
 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 Information Authority for awards and grants to state agencies
 and units of local government, to include operational
 activities and programs undertaken by the Authority, in
 support of Federal Crime Bill Initiatives.
- Section 45. The sum of \$12,440,000, or so much thereof
 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Juvenile
 Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the
 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards
 and grants to state agencies and units of local government,
 including operational expenses of the Authority in support of
 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program.
- 30 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 31 2006.
