SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois recognizes certain dates of 3 the year for honoring specific patriotic, civic, cultural and 4 historic persons, activities, symbols, or events; and

WHEREAS, On June 20, 1782, the American eagle 5 was designated as the National Emblem of the United States when the 6 7 Great Seal of the United States was adopted, and is the living symbol of the United States' freedoms, spirit and strength; in 8 9 December 1818, shortly after the Illinois Territory gained 10 statehood, the bald eagle became part of Great Seal of the State of Illinois; and 11

12 WHEREAS, Found only in North America and once on the 13 endangered species list, the bald eagle population is now growing again, especially along the western border of Illinois; 14 while the natural domain of bald eagles is from Alaska to 15 16 California, and Maine to Florida, the great State of Illinois 17 provides a winter home for thousands of these majestic birds as they make their journey northwards to the upper Midwest and 18 Canada for spring nesting; and 19

20 WHEREAS, From December through February, Illinois is home 21 to the largest concentration of wintering bald eagles in the 22 Continental United States; eagle-watching has become а 23 thriving hobby and form of State tourism in at least 27 24 Illinois counties; organizations and municipalities many 25 across the State host annual eagle viewing and educational 26 events and celebrations; and

27 WHEREAS, Illinois is home to two major waterways; our 28 treasured Illinois River as it connects Lake Michigan to the 29 Mississippi River, and the mighty Mississippi River as it flows 30 along the western border, perfect habitats for eagles who must 31 live near large bodies of open water where there are fish to SJ0014 -2- LRB094 06742 CSA 36842 r eat and tall trees for nesting and roosts; therefore, be it
