SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Members of the United States Armed Forces and 2 3 their families are stationed at various military installations 4 throughout the United States; and WHEREAS, The children of those military families attend 5 local schools operated by local public school districts; and 6 7 WHEREAS, The presence of a federal military activity in a 8 school district increases enrollment in the district but also 9 reduces the local tax base by removing property from the tax rolls; and 10 11 WHEREAS, School districts also lose tax revenues (i) 12 through the provisions granted military personnel by the 13 Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act of 1940 and (ii) as a result of military families shopping in commissaries and 14 exchanges and thus not paying local sales taxes; and 15 WHEREAS, 16 Congress enacted Impact Aid legislation federal government's responsibility to 17 establishing the provide financial assistance to school districts on which the 18 government places a financial burden; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Impact Aid payments are provided from the federal 21 Department of Education to local public school districts that 22 educate "federally connected" students, and approximately 40% 23 of those Impact Aid funds go to districts educating the 24 children of military families; and 25 WHEREAS, Impact Aid supplements are made available from the Department of Defense to help school districts with significant 26 27 concentrations of military students deal with the consequences

of an inadequate local funding base, challenges associated with

base closures and realignments, deteriorating families, and

- WHEREAS, The Department of Defense Impact Aid supplement is needed to provide military children with the level of educational opportunity available to children in neighboring,
- 5 non-federally impacted school districts; therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 7 8 CONCURRING HEREIN, that we urge Congress to take all steps 9 necessary, by means of substantive legislation and by means of 10 appropriation, to provide adequate Impact Aid and Impact Aid supplement funding to the Department of Education and the 11 Department of Defense to ensure that the children of military 12 families attending local public schools receive the same level 13 14 educational opportunity available to children 15 neighboring, non-federally impacted school districts; and be it further 16
- 17 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this Resolution be sent 18 to the President of the United States Senate, the Minority 19 Leader of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United 20 States House of Representatives, the Minority Leader of the 21 United States House of Representatives, and each member of the 22 Illinois congressional delegation.
