- 16 Richwood Township attorney for more than 10 years; and
- WHEREAS, He was a member of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church
- in Peoria; he was a former member of Mount Hawley Country Club,
- 19 the Creve Coeur Club, and the University Club; and
- 20 WHEREAS, He was preceded in death by his son, James Jr.,

- 22 WHEREAS, The passing of James Paul Kellstedt is felt by all
- 23 who knew and loved him, especially his wife, Muriel; his
