- 7 and Bridget Sullivan Phelan; he married Marilyn Lucille "Lou"
- 8 Williams in May of 1958 in Peoria; and
- 9 WHEREAS, He was a World War II Army veteran and a member of 10 the Navy-Marine Club; and
- 11 WHEREAS, In addition to being the Richwoods Township 12 supervisor, he was a voter registrar and the state director of 13 the Township Officials Supervisors Division; he was a former president of the Peoria County Township Officials; he was a 14 15 former member of the Peoria County Board and a former Greater 16 Peoria Airport Authority commissioner; he was a former president and founding member of the Peoples Party of Peoria 17 Heights; and 18
 - WHEREAS, He was a printer at the Journal Star for 52 years; he was a past president of Peoria Typographical Local 29, a past president of Allied Printing Trades Council and an officer of the West Central Labor Council; he served on the board of directors of the Peoria Labor Temple and was a former director of the Peoria Labor News; he served as a delegate to numerous national and state Typographical and AFL-CIO conventions; and
 - WHEREAS, He was the recipient of the West Central Labor Council Community Service Award and served as grand marshal of the Peoria Labor Day parade in 2002; he served as the Journal Star Red Stocking Santa Claus for many years; he was a charter member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians and was Hibernian of

- 2 Peoria and was grand marshall of the St. Patrick's Day 2001
- 3 parade; he was a former member of the Peoria-Tazewell Heart
- 4 Association board, and in 1995 received the Peoria Heights
- 5 Outstanding Citizen of the Year award presented by Peoria
- 6 Heights Chamber of Commerce; he was a former board member of
- 7 the Rural Peoria County Council on Aging and delivered Meals on
- 8 Wheels for more than 10 years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A member of St. Thomas Catholic Church in Peoria,
- 10 he was past president of its Men's Club and was head usher at
- 11 the church; he also was a member of Knights of Columbus 427
- 12 Third Degree Spalding Council for 69 years; and
- 13 WHEREAS, He was preceded in death by one brother and one
- 14 sister; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The passing of Edward Michael Phelan is felt by
- all who knew and loved him, especially his wife, Marilyn "Lou";
