21 WHEREAS, The passing of Reverend Abraham Byrd has been 22 deeply felt by many, especially his wife, Dorothy; his son, 23 Eddie Byrd, and his wife, Della; his grandchildren, Brian Byrd 24 and his wife, Joy, and Kelly and Brandon Byrd; and his 25 great-grandsons, Simon and Devon Byrd; he was preceded in death 26 by his parents and 12 siblings; therefore, be it
