- joined True Christian Fellowship Church under the leadership of
- 16 her brother, Rev. Andrew Payton; and
- 17 WHEREAS, She later married Samuel (Sam) Freeman, her
- 18 friend, companion, and traveling mate; and

- famous white potato pies, jello molds, and fresh coconut cakes,
