WHEREAS, Illinois' life science and biotechnology industry 2 3 is a national leader in developing innovative products and 4 techniques to improve the quality of healthcare, agriculture, manufacturing, environment, and homeland defense; and 5 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois is ranked among the top 6 7 three states in the country for life science and biotechnology; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, It is desirable for Illinois' biotechnology 10 industry, which directly or indirectly employs more than 127,000 people in Illinois, to continue to grow rapidly and to 11 generate increased State revenue and high paying jobs for 12 13 Illinois citizens; and WHEREAS, According to a recent national study, only two 14 15 states Illinois and California have sizable employment in all 16 major life sciences specialties: research development; medical devices and instruments; pharmaceuticals 17 and medicine; and agriculture, food, and chemicals; and 18 WHEREAS, In April 2006, the City of Chicago and State of 19 will host "The Olympics of Biotech" -20 Illinois The 21 Biotechnology International Convention; and 22 WHEREAS, The Biotechnology International Convention is 23 expected to attract more than 20,000 participants and attendees 24 from more than 65 countries; therefore, be it 25 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the Senate directs the 26 27 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to work with

the Office of the Governor, the General Assembly, the City of

Chicago, and the Illinois Biotechnology Industry Organization

- and other representative members of the industry: (i) to
 formulate and make recommendations and to thereafter report to
 the Senate those recommendations regarding the State's
 commitment to the continued growth and development of the life
 sciences and biotechnology in the State of Illinois; and (ii)
 to identify measures and make recommendations to promote and
 market "BIO 2006", the BIO International Convention scheduled
