5 WHEREAS, He was born on July 12, 1933, in Herrin, to Floyd 6 "Grassy" and Fern (Compton) Walker; he was a standout football 7 player at Herrin High School in the 1950s and was a member of 8 the Class of 1951; he was inducted into the Herrin High School 9 Hall of Fame in 1997; and

WHEREAS, He married Adeline (Toigo) in Marion on November 13, 1964; he was the retired vice president, CEO of the Bank of Herrin and a longtime Herrin businessman, retiring in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Walker valiantly served his country as a member of the U.S. Army during the Korean War; he was a member of the Herrin Elks, Pigion Inn, the American Legion, Rotary Club, the Herrin Chamber of Commerce, First United Methodist Church, and he served on the Herrin Civic Center Board; he enjoyed golfing at Franklin County Country Club and Crab Orchard Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, He was very active in the Herrin community and played an important role in numerous projects, including helping to organize the Herrinfesta Italiana Golf Tournament; volunteer work was a way of life for him; in 2001, he was honored by the Herrin Spokesman as one of the area's Unsung Heroes; and

WHEREAS, The passing of Denzil R. Walker has been deeply felt by many, especially his wife, Adeline Walker; his daughters, Delina and her husband Peter Nugent, Holly and her husband Vern Larkin, and Kelly King; his six grandchildren; his one great-grandchild; his brothers, Jerry and his wife Joyce
