1 SENATE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, Diabetes is one our nation's greatest health 3 risks, affecting approximately 18.2 million people in the United States, roughly 6.2% of the population; and 4 WHEREAS, The 2 main forms of diabetes are Type 1 and Type 2 5 diabetes; Type 1 diabetes results from the body's failure to produce insulin, and Type 2 diabetes results from insulin 7 8 resistance combined with relative insulin deficiency; and 9 WHEREAS, Children are affected by Type 1 diabetes, and the number of children affected by diabetes is growing; and 10 WHEREAS, The 94th General Assembly has passed House Bill 11 12 1581, which creates the Diabetes Research Check-off Fund and 13 provides that, from the Fund, the Department of Human Services must make grants to public or private entities for diabetes 14 research; and 15 WHEREAS, The Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation funds 16 research on diabetes that affects children; and 17 WHEREAS, The American Diabetes Association supports basic 18 and clinical research for both Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes aimed 19 20 at preventing, treating, and curing diabetes; and 21 WHEREAS, Illinoisans rank second, behind Mississippi, in 22 meeting target levels of scores on Alc hemoglobin tests, making 23 it the second worst state in the nation at controlling 24 diabetes; therefore, be it 25 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Department 26

of Human Services to disburse the moneys in the Diabetes

Research Check-off Fund as grants for the research of diabetes
