- 20th Congressional District Cope; he was a Democratic Precinct
- 16 Committeeman and was active in the political process all of his
- 17 adult working life, working to pass legislation in Washington,
- 18 D.C., and Springfield; and
- 19 WHEREAS, He was a member and elected trustee of Eagles
- 20 Aerie 254, Piasa Masonic Lodge 27, Scottish Rite 32nd Degree
- 21 Mason, and a Shriner of the Ainad Rolling Nobles three-wheeler
- 22 unit, entertaining crowds for 17 years, having fun, and helping
- 23 kids; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The passing of Paul M. Clark has been deeply felt
- 25 by many, especially his wife, Edie; his daughters and their
- husbands, Paula and Dan Resavage and their two children, Fallon
- 27 and Ryan, and Jennifer and Minas Konstadinopulos and their two
