



1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the State of Illinois
3 learned with sadness of the death of Edgar "Ed" Dulli of
4 Naperville on June 10, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Dulli was born on January 22, 1948, in
6 Hamilton, Ohio, to Edgar and Edna Dulli; he grew up in

16 enjoyed traveling world wide, attending concerts and the
17 theater, dancing and golf; his greatest joy was spending time
18 with and "spoiling" his granddaughters; and

20 all who knew and loved him, especially his wife of 32 years,
21 Paula Dulli; his eldest daughter, Lisa; his son-in-law, Mike

24 sister, Nancy (Ron); and his many nieces and nephews; he was
