2           WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the State of Illinois  
3 wish to express their sincere condolences to the family and  
4 friends of Anthony Puccillo, Jr. of Westmont, who passed away  
5 on July 25, 2006; and

7 Moreland; he served with the U.S. Army during the Korean War;
