SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Richard Mervyn "Dick" Hall of Arlington 4 Heights, who passed away on November 3, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, Richard Mervyn "Dick" Hall was born on May 14, 6 1925, in Macomb, Illinois; his parents were Mervyn and Beryl 7 Hall; and

8 WHEREAS, After serving in the Army Air Corps, Richard Hall 9 attended the University of Illinois, Urbana, graduating in just 10 two and one-half years with a bachelor's degree in electrical 11 engineering; he was still working full-time as owner of a 12 commercial and industrial lighting fixture sales agency at the 13 time of his death; and

14 WHEREAS, Richard Hall was the longest-serving supervisor 15 out of 30 townships in Cook County; he began his 38 years of 16 public service with Elk Grove Township as a trustee in April 17 1968; he was first elected Elk Grove Township supervisor eight 18 years later in 1976 and was repeatedly re-elected, serving in 19 that position until his death; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Hall's legacy as township supervisor includes 21 a bicycle safety program for the township; the program now 22 trains between 5,000 to 7,000 children every year; he also 23 created the Elk Grove Township Community Day Care Center, so 24 that working mothers would have a place to bring their 25 children; and

Hall Drive; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was a life master in duplicate bridge and had mastered most major board games; he enjoyed spending time with his family, gardening with his natural "green thumb", cooking outdoors, even in the middle of winter, and playing with his special at-home friends, his cats; and
