SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/11-4.1

from Ch. 46, par. 11-4.1

Amends the Election Code. When a school is chosen for use as a polling place, requires that the school district close that school to students on election day (now, may choose to keep the school open).

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 11-4.1 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/11-4.1) (from Ch. 46, par. 11-4.1)
- 7 Sec. 11-4.1. (a) In appointing polling places under this
- 8 Article, the county board or board of election commissioners
- 9 shall, insofar as they are convenient and available, use
- schools and other public buildings as polling places.
- 11 (b) Upon request of the county board or board of election
- 12 commissioners, the proper agency of government (including
- 13 school districts and units of local government) shall make a
- 14 public building under its control available for use as a
- polling place on an election day and for a reasonably necessary
- 16 time before and after election day, without charge. If the
- 17 county board or board of election commissioners chooses a
- 18 school to be a polling place, then the school district must
- 19 make the school available for use as a polling place. For
- 20 However, for the day of the election, that a school district
- 21 <u>must close that</u> may choose to (i) keep the school to students
- 22 but may open or (ii) hold a teachers institute on that day.
- 23 (c) A government agency which makes a public building under

- 1 its control available for use as a polling place shall ensure
- 2 the portion of the building to be used as the polling place is
- 3 accessible to handicapped and elderly voters.
