- 12 (b) Sentence. Aggravated battery of an unborn child is a
- Class X  $\frac{2}{2}$  felony for which the person shall be sentenced to a
- 14 term of imprisonment of not less than 6 years and not more than
- 15 <u>45 years</u>.
