1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 215

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 215 as follows:

3 on page 2, line 2, after "capacity", by inserting "; the owner  
4 or operator of a livestock waste handling facility constructed  
5 with concrete with a design capacity of less than 300 animal  
6 units may demonstrate to the Department that a reduced storage  
7 volume, not less than 60 days, is feasible due to (i) the  
8 availability of land application areas that can receive manure  
9 at agronomic rates or (ii) another manure disposal method is  
10 proposed that will allow for the reduced manure storage design  
11 capacity; the Department shall evaluate the proposal and  
12 determine whether a reduced manure storage design capacity is  
13 appropriate for the site"; and

14 on page 3, line 2, by replacing "3 6" with "6"; and

15 on page 3, line 3, after "capacity", by inserting ". The owner

1 or operator of a livestock waste handling facility holding  
2 solid livestock waste with a design capacity of less than 300  
3 animal units may demonstrate to the Department that a reduced  
4 storage volume, not less than 2 months, is feasible due to (i)  
5 the availability of land application areas that can receive  
6 manure at agronomic rates or (ii) another manure disposal  
7 method is proposed that will allow for the reduced storage  
8 design capacity. The Department shall evaluate the proposal and  
9 determine whether a reduced manure storage design capacity is  
10 appropriate for the site".
