## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, and 5 Coal Resources Development Law of 1997 is amended by adding 6 Section 6-5.5 as follows:

- 7 (20 ILCS 687/6-5.5 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 6-5.5. Renewable energy grants.</u>

9 <u>(a) Subject to appropriation, the Department may establish</u> 10 <u>and operate a renewable energy grant program to assist school</u> 11 <u>districts in the installation, acquisition, construction, and</u> 12 <u>improvement of renewable energy resources in the public</u> 13 <u>schools, including without limitation solar energy (such as</u> 14 <u>solar panels), geothermal energy, and wind energy.</u>

15 (b) Application for a grant under this Section must be in 16 the form and manner established by the Department. The grant 17 shall cover 50% of the cost for which the grant is sought, up 18 to a maximum grant of \$1,000,000, if the applicant school 19 district is able to demonstrate that it has funds to pay the 20 other 50% of the cost. The school district may accept private 21 funds for its portion of the cost.

(c) The Department may adopt any rules that are necessary
to carry out its responsibilities under this Section.
