## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 12 as follows:

18	Illinois Identification Card issued on or after January 1,
19	2005; and (ii) $80\%$ $80\%$ of the $10\%$ fee for a corrected Illinois
20	Identification Card issued on or after January 1, 2005.
21	Any disabled person making an application for a standard
22	Illinois Identification Card for no fee must, along with the
23	application, submit an affirmation by the applicant on a form
24	to be provided by the Secretary of State, attesting that such
25	person is a disabled person as defined in Section 4A of this

An individual, who resides in a veterans home or veterans 1 2 hospital operated by the state or federal government, who makes 3 an application for an Illinois Identification Card to be issued at no fee, must submit, along with the application, an 4 5 affirmation by the applicant on a form provided by the 6 Secretary of State, that such person resides in a veterans home 7 or veterans hospital operated by the state or federal 8 government.
