Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 12-610.1 as follows:

7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.

8 (a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a 9 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic 10 communications without a wire connecting the device to the 11 telephone network.

(b) A person under the age of <u>19</u> 18 years who holds an instruction permit issued under Section 6 105 or 6 107.1, or a person under the age of 18 years who holds a graduated license issued under Section 6 107, may not drive a vehicle on a roadway while using a wireless phone.

(c) This Section does not apply to a person under the age of <u>19</u> 18 years using a wireless telephone for emergency purposes, including, but not limited to, an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity.

22 (d) A violation of this Section is a petty offense
23 punishable by a fine of \$100.
