1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
14-6.10 as follows:

Sec. 14-6.10. Transfer of parental rights at the age of
majority.

9 (a) When a student who is eligible for special education under this Article reaches the majority age of 18 years, all 10 rights accorded to the student's parents under this Article 11 transfer to the student, except as provided in this Section. 12 This transfer of rights also applies to student's who are 13 14 incarcerated in an adult or juvenile State or local correctional institution. Nothing in this Section shall be 15 16 construed to deny a student with a disability who has reached 17 majority age the right to have an adult of his or her choice, including, but not limited to, the student's parent, assist the 18 19 student in making decisions regarding the student's 20 individualized education program.

21 (b) The school district must notify the student and the 22 student's parents of the transfer of rights in writing at a 23 meeting convened to review the student's individualized HB0816 Engrossed - 2 - LRB095 08194 NHT 28362 b

1 education program during the school year in which the student 2 turns 17 years of age. The school district must also explain to 3 the student and the student's parents the significance of the transfer of parental rights at the majority age of 18. At that 4 5 time, the school district must provide the student with a copy of the Delegation of Rights form described in this Section. 6 7 (c) Rights shall not transfer from the parents to the 8 student under this Section if either of the following apply: 9 (1) The student with a disability who has reached the 10 age of majority has been adjudged incompetent under State 11 law. 12 (2) The student has not been adjudged incompetent under State law, but the student has executed a Delegation of 13 14 Rights to make educational decisions pursuant to this 15 Section for the purpose of appointing the student's parent 16 or other adult to represent the educational interests of 17 the student. A student may terminate the Delegation of Rights at any 18 19 time and assume the right to make decisions regarding his or 20 her education. The Delegation of Rights shall meet all of the 21 following requirements: 22 (A) It shall remain in effect for one year after the 23 date of execution, but may be renewed annually with the 24 written or other formal authorization of the student and 25 the person the student delegates to represent the 26 educational interests of the student.

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1	(B) It shall be signed by the student or verified by
2	other means, such as audio or video or other alternative
3	format compatible with the student's disability showing
4	that the student has agreed to the terms of the delegation.
5	(C) It shall be signed or otherwise manifest
6	verification that the designee accepts the delegation.
7	(D) It shall include declarations that the student (i)
8	is 18 years of age or older, (ii) intends to delegate his
9	or her educational rights under federal and State law to a
10	specified individual who is at least 18 years of age, (iii)
11	has not been adjudged incompetent under State law, (iv) is
12	entitled to be present during the development of the
13	student's individualized education program and to raise
14	issues or concerns about the student's individualized
15	education program, and (v) will be permitted to terminate
16	the Designation of Rights at any time.
17	(E) It shall be identical or substantially the same as
18	the following form:
19	DELEGATION OF RIGHTS TO MAKE EDUCATIONAL DECISION
20	I, (insert name), am 18 years of age or older and a student
21	who has the right to make educational decisions for myself
22	under State and federal law. I have not been adjudged
23	incompetent and, as of the date of the execution of this
24	document, I hereby delegate my right to give consent and make

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decisions concerning my education to (insert name), who will be 1 considered my "parent" for purposes of the Individuals with 2 3 Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 and Article 14 4 of the School Code and will exercise all of the rights and 5 responsibilities concerning my education that are conferred on a parent under those laws. I understand and give my consent for 6 7 (insert name) to make all decisions relating to my education on 8 my behalf. I understand that I have the right to be present at 9 meetings held to develop my individualized education program and that I have the right to raise any issues or concerns I may 10 11 have and that the school district must consider them.

12 <u>This delegation will be in effect for one year from the</u> 13 <u>date of execution below and may be renewed by my written or</u> 14 <u>other formal authorization. I also understand that I have the</u> 15 <u>right to terminate this Delegation of Rights at any time and</u> 16 <u>assume the right to make my own decisions regarding my</u> 17 <u>education.</u>
