Amends the Animal Control Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning impounding dogs.

1 AN ACT concerning animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing

 Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 5/9) (from Ch. 8, par. 359)
- 7 Sec. 9. Any dog found running at large contrary to provisions of this Act may be apprehended and and impounded. 8 9 For this purpose, the Administrator shall utilize any existing 10 available animal control facility or licensed animal shelter. The dog's owner shall pay a \$25 public safety fine, 11 \$20 of which shall be deposited into the Pet Population Control 12 Fund and \$5 of which shall be retained by the county or 13 14 municipality. A dog found running at large contrary to the provisions of this Act a second or subsequent time must be 15 16 spayed or neutered within 30 days after being reclaimed unless 17 already spayed or neutered; failure to comply shall result in impoundment. 18
