

## 95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 HB1024

Introduced 2/8/2007, by Rep. Richard P. Myers

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.675 new 625 ILCS 5/3-664 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code and the State Finance Act. Creates the Illinois Agriculture in the Classroom Fund in the State treasury. Provides for the issuance of Agriculture in the Classroom license plates. Provides that in addition to the appropriate registration fees, an applicant for the special plate shall be charged a fee of \$40 at original issuance and \$27 renewal in subsequent years. Provides that \$25 of the additional original issuance fee and the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund. Provides that \$15 of the original issuance fee and \$2 of the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the Secretary of State, all moneys in the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund shall be paid as grants to the Illinois Agricultural Association Foundation to support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for schools. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.675 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.675 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.675. The Agriculture in the Classroom Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
- 9 Section 3-664 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-664 new)
- 11 Sec. 3-664. Agriculture in the Classroom plates.
- 12 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
- issue special registration plates designated as Agriculture in
- the Classroom license plates.
- The special plates issued under this Section shall be
- 17 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or
- 18 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than
- 19 8,000 pounds.
- 20 Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to
- 21 the multi year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this

- 2 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be 3 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary.
- (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a

  \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate

  registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the

  Agriculture in the Classroom Fund and \$15 shall be deposited

  into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be

  used by the Secretary to help defray the administrative
- For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in

  addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.

  Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Agriculture in the

  Classroom Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of

  State Special License Plate Fund.
  - (d) The Agriculture in the Classroom Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the Secretary, to the Illinois Agricultural Association Foundation, a charitable organization that meets the requirements of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to be used as grants to support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public and private schools within Illinois.
    - Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon

becoming law. 1
