SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

230 ILCS 10/4

from Ch. 120, par. 2404

Amends the Riverboat Gambling Act. Changes the definition of "adjusted gross receipts" to exclude qualified contributions. Defines "qualified contributions" as monies paid by the owner licensee pursuant to a previous agreement with the Board to (i) Illinois-based 501(c)(3) organizations or (ii) a unit of local government for the purpose of promoting education, environmental, or economic development programs. Effective June 1, 2007.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Riverboat Gambling Act is amended by 5 changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (230 ILCS 10/4) (from Ch. 120, par. 2404)

7 Sec. 4. Definitions. As used in this Act:

8 (a) "Board" means the Illinois Gaming Board.

9 (b) "Occupational license" means a license issued by the 10 Board to a person or entity to perform an occupation which the 11 Board has identified as requiring a license to engage in 12 riverboat gambling in Illinois.

(c) "Gambling game" includes, but is not limited to, baccarat, twenty-one, poker, craps, slot machine, video game of chance, roulette wheel, klondike table, punchboard, faro layout, keno layout, numbers ticket, push card, jar ticket, or pull tab which is authorized by the Board as a wagering device under this Act.

(d) "Riverboat" means a self-propelled excursion boat, a permanently moored barge, or permanently moored barges that are permanently fixed together to operate as one vessel, on which lawful gambling is authorized and licensed as provided in this Act. - 2 - LRB095 10896 AMC 31180 b

(e) "Managers license" means a license issued by the Board
 to a person or entity to manage gambling operations conducted
 by the State pursuant to Section 7.3 7.2.

4 (f) "Dock" means the location where a riverboat moors for
5 the purpose of embarking passengers for and disembarking
6 passengers from the riverboat.

7 (g) "Gross receipts" means the total amount of money
8 exchanged for the purchase of chips, tokens or electronic cards
9 by riverboat patrons.

(h) "Adjusted gross receipts" means the gross receipts less
 (i) winnings paid to wagerers and (ii) qualified contributions.

(i) "Cheat" means to alter the selection of criteria which determine the result of a gambling game or the amount or frequency of payment in a gambling game.

(j) "Department" means the Department of Revenue.

16 (k) "Gambling operation" means the conduct of authorized 17 gambling games upon a riverboat.

(1) "License bid" means the lump sum amount of money that
an applicant bids and agrees to pay the State in return for an
owners license that is re-issued on or after July 1, 2003.

(m) The terms "minority person" and "female" shall have the same meaning as defined in Section 2 of the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities Act.

(n) "Qualified contributions" means monies paid by the
 owner licensee pursuant to a previous agreement with the Board
 to (i) Illinois-based 501(c) (3) organizations or (ii) a unit of
