1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Public Health Powers and
 Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
 amended by adding Section 2310-635 as follows:

- Sec. 2310-635. Healthy Smiles Fund; grants. Subject to 8 9 appropriation, the Department of Public Health has the power to make grants or use moneys in the Healthy Smiles Fund, a special 10 fund created in the State treasury, to secure federal matching 11 grants to provide for quality assurance program evaluation 12 13 activities for school-based, school-linked oral health 14 programs operating under the auspices of either the Department of Public Health or the Department of Healthcare and Family 15 16 Services. The Department shall accept and deposit with the 17 State Treasurer all gifts, grants, transfers, appropriations, and other amounts from any legal source, public or private, 18 19 that are designated for deposit into the Fund.
- 20 Section 10. The State Finance Act is amended by adding 21 Section 5.675 as follows:

- 8 years ending on or after December 31, 2008, the Department must
- 9 print on its standard individual income tax form a provision
- 10 indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the
- Healthy Smiles Fund, as authorized by this amendatory Act of
- the 95th General Assembly, he or she may do so by stating the
- amount of the contribution (not less than \$1) on the return and
- 14 that the contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or
- increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure
- 16 to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the
- 17 <u>contribution accordingly. This Section does not apply to any</u>
- 18 amended return.

- Sec. 509. Tax checkoff explanations. All individual income
- 21 tax return forms shall contain appropriate explanations and
- 22 spaces to enable the taxpayers to designate contributions to

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Illinois Wildlife Preservation Fund (as required by the Illinois Non-Game Wildlife Protection Act), the Alzheimer's Disease Research Fund (as required by the Alzheimer's Disease Research Act), the Assistance to the Homeless Fund (as required by this Act), the Penny Severns Breast and Cervical Cancer Research Fund, the National World War II Memorial Fund, the Prostate Cancer Research Fund, the Lou Gehrig's Disease (ALS) Research Fund, the Multiple Sclerosis Assistance Fund, the Sarcoidosis Research Fund. t.he Leukemia Treatment. and Education Fund, the World War II Illinois Veterans Memorial Fund, the Korean War Veterans National Museum and Library Fund, the Illinois Military Family Relief Fund, the Blindness Prevention Fund, the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund, the Epilepsy Treatment and Education Grants-in-Aid Fund, Diabetes Research Checkoff Fund, the Vince Demuzio Memorial Colon Cancer Fund, the Autism Research Fund, the Heartsaver AED Fund, the Asthma and Lung Research Fund, the Healthy Smiles Fund, and the Illinois Brain Tumor Research Fund.

Each form shall contain a statement that the contributions will reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly.

If, on October 1 of any year, the total contributions to any one of the funds made under this Section do not equal \$100,000 or more, the explanations and spaces for designating contributions to the fund shall be removed from the individual
