SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/12-16.3 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of sexual battery. Provides that a person commits the offense when he or she intentionally or knowingly without legal justification makes physical contact with the intimate body parts of a victim who was 17 years of age or older at the time of the commission of the offense, without that person's consent. Defines intimate body parts. Provides that a violation is a Class A misdemeanor. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
- 5 Section 12-16.3 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/12-16.3 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 12-16.3. Sexual battery.</u>
- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of sexual battery when he
- 9 or she intentionally or knowingly without legal justification
- 10 makes physical contact with the intimate body parts of a victim
- 11 who was 17 years of age or older at the time of the commission
- of the offense, without that person's consent.
- 13 (b) For purposes of this Section, "intimate body parts"
- includes the primary genital area, anus, groin, inner thighs,
- buttocks, or breasts of a male or female.
- (c) <u>Sentence.</u> Sexual battery is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 18 becoming law.
