## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 25/8.1

from Ch. 111, par. 2308.1

Amends the Illinois Dental Practice Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the administration of general anesthesia or conscious sedation.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended by changing Section 8.1 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 25/8.1) (from Ch. 111, par. 2308.1)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)
- 8 Sec. 8.1. No licensed dentist shall administer general
- 9 anesthesia or conscious sedation without first applying for <u>and</u>
- 10 and obtaining a permit for such purpose from the Department.
- 11 The Department shall issue such permit only after ascertaining
- 12 that the applicant possesses the minimum qualifications
- 13 necessary to protect public safety. A person with a dental
- 14 degree who administers anesthesia or conscious sedation in an
- 15 approved hospital training program under the supervision of
- 16 either a licensed dentist holding such permit or a physician
- 17 licensed to practice medicine in all its branches shall not be
- 18 required to obtain such permit.
