

95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 HB1715

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

In addition to any amounts previously appropriated for that purpose, appropriates \$33,700,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services to fund a full 3% cost-of-doing-business increase in the topline rates paid to private sector agencies serving individuals with developmental disabilities. Appropriates \$10,000,000 to the Department for a similar increase in the rates paid to private sector agencies serving individuals with mental illness. Effective July 1, 2007.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 5. In addition to any amounts previously appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$33,700,000, or so 5 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from 6 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services 7 to fund a full 3% cost-of-doing-business increase in the 8 9 topline rates paid to private sector agencies individuals with developmental disabilities. 10

Section 10. In addition to any amounts previously appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$10,000,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services to fund a full 3% cost-of-doing-business increase in the topline rates paid to private sector agencies serving individuals with mental illness.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
