4 Section 5. The Illinois Human Rights Act is amended by 5 adding Section 7-112.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 7-112.5. Training tuition. The Department is authorized to charge tuition to non-governmental entities, 8 9 other than not for profit groups or organizations in Illinois that have no more than 50 employees, for training offered by 10 the Department's Institute for Training and Development. The 11 tuition shall be paid into the Department of Human Rights 12 Training and Development Fund, a special fund that is created 13 14 in the State treasury. Moneys in the Fund shall be used to: (i) enhance the quality of the Department's training services; (ii) 15 make training available at no cost to not for profit groups or 16 17 organizations in Illinois that have no more than 50 employees, Department employees, other State agencies 18 and 19 instrumentalities of the State, and community organizations; 20 and (iii) make training available to any other non-governmental 21 entities on a tuition basis.
