1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much of that
5	amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois
6	Department of Human Services, Division of Alcoholism and
7	Substance Abuse, to fund services for 2260 substance abusing
8	offenders, including:
9	(1) abuse treatment provided by organizations

- licensed by the Department of Human Services to do so; and

 (2) screening, assessment and case management performed by the program designated by the State
- under Section 40-5 of the Alcoholism and Other Drug
- Abuse and Dependency Act; and
- 16 (3) other recovery support services.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
