#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/7-615 new  
625 ILCS 5/7-620 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that, in addition to any other fine or penalty, a law enforcement official may impound the motor vehicle of any person operating that vehicle without insurance. Requires the Secretary of State to establish and maintain a database of all motor vehicles determined by the Secretary to be uninsured and requires that this database be available to federal, state, and local law-enforcement agencies.

1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Sections 7-615 and 7-620 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/7-615 new)

7 Sec. 7-615. Impounding uninsured vehicles. In addition to  
8 any other fine or penalty under this Code, a law enforcement  
9 official may impound the motor vehicle of any person operating  
10 that vehicle in violation of subsection (a) of Section 7-601.

11 (625 ILCS 5/7-620 new)

12 Sec. 7-620. Uninsured motorist database. The Secretary of  
13 State shall establish and maintain a database of all motor  
14 vehicles determined by the Secretary to be in violation of  
15 Section 7-601 of this Code. This database must be available to  
16 federal, state, and local law-enforcement agencies.
