1 AN ACT concerning public health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Quality Nursing Home Care Survey Act.
- Section 5. Quality nursing home care survey pilot program.
