A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)

7 Sec. 1. When at any general election for the ~~the~~ office of  
8 Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, the Governor,  
9 within 2 weeks after such election, shall provide space for not  
10 more than 5 persons designated by the Governor-elect to enable  
11 the Governor-elect to begin a review and analysis of budgeted  
12 expenditures during the then current biennium and budget  
13 requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a working  
14 knowledge of the various offices, departments, commissions,  
15 boards and other agencies of the executive branch of the State  
16 government. The Governor shall cooperate with the  
17 Governor-elect and the staff so designated by him and provide  
18 any assistance that may be reasonably requested.
