# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended
by changing Section 22.4 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 505/22.4) (from Ch. 23, par. 5022.4)

Sec. 22.4. Low-interest loans for child care facilities; Department of Human Services. <u>The</u> The Department of Human Services may establish, with financing to be provided through the issuance of bonds by the Illinois Finance Authority pursuant to the Illinois Finance Authority Act, a low-interest loan program to help child care centers and family day care homes accomplish the following:

(a) establish a child care program;

(b) meet federal, State and local child care standards
as well as any applicable health and safety standards; or

17 (c) build facilities or renovate or expand existing18 facilities.

Such loans shall be available only to child care centers and family day care homes serving children of low income families.
