1 AN ACT concerning employment.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Day and Temporary Labor Services Act is 5 amended by changing Section 75 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 175/75)

7 Sec. 75. Willful violations.

8 (a) Whoever willfully violates any of <u>the</u> the provisions of 9 this Act or any rule adopted under this Act, or whoever 10 obstructs the Department of Labor, its inspectors or deputies, 11 or any other person authorized to inspect places of employment 12 under this Act shall be liable for penalties up to double the 13 statutory amount.

14 (b) Whoever willfully violates any of the provisions of this Act or any rule adopted under this Act which results in an 15 16 underpayment to a day or temporary laborer shall be liable to 17 the Department for up to 20% of the day and temporary labor service agency's or the third party client's total underpayment 18 19 and shall also be liable to the employee for punitive damages in the amount of 2% of the amount of any such underpayments for 20 21 each month following the date of payment during which the 22 underpayments remain unpaid.

(c) The Director may promulgate rules for the collection of

these penalties. The penalty shall be imposed in cases in which a day and temporary labor service agency's or a third party client's conduct is proven by a preponderance of the evidence to be willful. The penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Director of Labor in any circuit court. In any such action, the Director of Labor shall be represented by the Attorney General.
