1 (1) secured by a device or mechanism, other than the firearm safety, designed to render a firearm temporarily 2 3 inoperable; or 4 (2) placed in a securely locked box or container; or 5 (3) placed in some other location that a reasonable person would believe to be secure from a minor under the 6 7 age of 14 years. 8 (b) Sentence. A person who violates this Section is guilty 9 of a Class C misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than 10 \$1,000. A second or subsequent violation of this Section is a Class A misdemeanor. 11 (c) Subsection (a) does not apply: 12 (1) if the minor under 14 years of age gains access to 13 a firearm and uses it in a lawful act of self-defense or 14 15 defense of another: or 16 (2) to any firearm obtained by a minor under the age of 14 because of an unlawful entry of the premises by the 17 18 minor or another person. (d) For the purposes of this Section, "firearm" has the 19 20 meaning ascribed to it in Section 1.1 of the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. 21 (Source: P.A. 91-18, eff. 1-1-00.)". 22
