725 ILCS 5/115-8

from Ch. 38, par. 115-8

Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning a defendant's waiver of his or her right to be present during trial.

- 4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 5 amended by changing Section 115-8 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/115-8) (from Ch. 38, par. 115-8)
- 7 Sec. 115-8.
- A defendant may waive his right to be present during trial.
- 9 However, upon motion of the the State's Attorney made prior to
- or during trial, the court shall order the defendant to present
- 11 himself in open court for the purpose of identification.
