2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax
Act is amended by changing Section 5-5 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 636/5-5)

7 Sec. 5-5. Legislative intent. The The General Assembly has authorized the corporate authorities of any municipality to 8 9 impose various fees and taxes on the privilege of originating 10 or receiving telecommunications, and on retailers engaged in the business of transmitting such telecommunications, all of 11 which are remitted by such retailers directly to the imposing 12 municipality. To simplify the imposition and collection of 13 municipal telecommunications taxes and to reduce complication 14 and burden, the General Assembly is repealing the municipal 15 telecommunications tax, the municipal tax on the occupation or 16 17 privilege of transmitting messages, and the municipal maintenance fee, 18 infrastructure and is enacting this 19 Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax Act which provides 20 for a single municipally imposed telecommunications tax which, 21 for municipalities with populations of less than 500,000, will 22 be collected by the Illinois Department of Revenue, but which, for municipalities of 500,000 or more, will continue to be 23
