Section 5. The Illinois Optometric Practice Act of 1987 is
amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 80/4) (from Ch. 111, par. 3904)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2017)

8 Sec. 4. No person shall practice, or attempt to practice, 9 optometry, as defined in this Act, without a valid license as 10 an optometrist issued by the the Department.
