AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
21-5 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/21-5) (from Ch. 122, par. 21-5)

7 Sec. 21-5. High school certificate.

(a) A high school certificate shall be valid for 4 years 8 9 for teaching in grades 6 to 12 inclusive of the the common schools. Subject to the provisions of Section 21-1a, it shall 10 be issued to persons who have graduated from a recognized 11 institution of higher learning with a bachelor's degree and 12 with not fewer than 120 semester hours including 16 semester 13 14 hours in professional education, 5 of which shall be in student teaching under competent and close supervision and with one or 15 16 more teaching fields. Such persons shall be recommended for the 17 high school certificate by a recognized institution as having completed an approved program of preparation which includes the 18 19 academic and professional courses approved by the State Superintendent of Education in consultation with the State 20 21 Teacher Certification Board.

(b) Beginning February 15, 2000, Initial and Standard
 Secondary Certificates shall be issued to persons who meet all
