

## 95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 HB3388

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 412/20

Amends the Electrologist Licensing Act. Provides that nothing in the Act shall be construed to prevent a person employed as a medical assistant by a physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches from assisting the physician in the practice of electrology (now, nothing in the Act shall be construed to prevent a person functioning as an assistant to a person licensed to practice medicine in all its branches from providing electrology services), and that the Act does not authorize an unlicensed person to provide electrology services.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Electrologist Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 20 as follows:

- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2014)
- 8 Sec. 20. Exemptions. This Act does not prohibit:
- 9 (1) A person licensed in this State under any other Act
  10 from engaging in the practice for which that person is
  11 licensed.
  - (2) The practice of electrology by a person who is employed by the United States government or any bureau, division, or agency thereof while in the discharge of the employee's official duties.
  - (3) The practice of electrology included in a program of study by students enrolled in schools or in refresher courses approved by the Department.
  - Nothing in this Act shall be construed to prevent a person employed functioning as a medical an assistant by to a physician person licensed to practice medicine in all its branches from assisting the physician in the practice of providing electrology services. This Act does not authorize an
