1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Taxi
 Safety Act of 2007.
- 6 Section 5. Requirements for the operation of taxicabs.
- 7 (a) The taxi driver's picture and any license or 8 registration number must be posted in a visible location in 9 each cab.
 - (b) There must be posted in a visible location in each taxicab a telephone number for a passenger to call if the taxi driver is operating the taxicab in a reckless manner. Law enforcement officers must respond to stop any taxicab if a passenger calls from inside that taxicab.
 - (c) If a taxi driver collides with a pedestrian while operating a taxicab, resulting in bodily injury, then any responding law enforcement officers must test the taxi driver for drug and alcohol use.
- Section 20. Home rule. A home rule unit may not regulate the operation of taxicabs in a manner that is less restrictive than the regulation by the State of the operation of taxicabs under this Act. This Section is a limitation under subsection

- (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on 1
- the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and 2
- functions exercised by the State. 3
