1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 262)
- 7 Sec. 2.
- 8 Unfair methods of competition <u>and</u> and unfair or deceptive
- 9 acts or practices, including but not limited to the use or
- 10 employment of any deception fraud, false pretense, false
- 11 promise, misrepresentation or the concealment, suppression or
- omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely
- upon the concealment, suppression or omission of such material
- 14 fact, or the use or employment of any practice described in
- 15 Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act",
- 16 approved August 5, 1965, in the conduct of any trade or
- 17 commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether any person has in
- 18 fact been misled, deceived or damaged thereby. In construing
- 19 this section consideration shall be given to the
- 20 interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal
- 21 courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the Federal Trade
- 22 Commission Act.
