## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Flag Display Act is amended by adding Section 10 as follows:

- Sec. 10. Death of resident military member or law enforcement officer.
- 9 (a) The Governor shall issue an official notice to fly the following flags at half-staff upon the death of a resident of 10 this State killed (i) by hostile fire as a member of the United 11 12 States armed forces or (ii) in the line of duty as a law enforcement officer: the United States national flag, the State 13 14 flag of Illinois, and, in the case of the death of the member of the United States armed forces, the appropriate military 15 flag as defined in subsection (b) of Section 18.6 of the 16 17 Condominium Property Act. Upon the Governor's notice, each person or entity required by this Act to ensure the display of 18 19 the United States national flag on a flagstaff shall ensure that the flags described in the notice are displayed at 20 21 half-staff on the day designated for the resident's funeral and
- 23 (b) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall notify the

the 2 days preceding that day.

- 3 State Police shall notify the Governor of the death in the line
- 4 of duty of an Illinois resident law enforcement officer. Notice

- (c) For the purpose of this Section, the United States 8
- 9 armed forces includes: (i) the United States Army, Navy, Marine
- 10 Corps, Air Force, and Coast Guard; (ii) any reserve component
- 11 of each of the forces listed in item (i); and (iii) the
- 12 National Guard.
- 13 (d) Nothing in this Section requires the removal or
- relocation of any existing flags currently displayed in the 14
- State. This Section does not apply to a State facility if the 15
- 16 requirements of this Section cannot be satisfied without a
- 17 physical modification to that facility.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 18
- 19 becoming law.
