1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 111, par. 5351)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2017)
- 8 Sec. 1. <u>The</u> practice of clinical psychology in Illinois
- 9 is hereby declared to affect the public health, safety and
- 10 welfare, and to be subject to regulations in the public
- 11 interest to protect the public from persons who are
- 12 unauthorized or unqualified to represent themselves as
- 13 clinical psychologists or as being able to render clinical
- 14 psychological services as herein defined, and from
- 15 unprofessional conduct by persons licensed to practice
- 16 clinical psychology. This Act shall be known and may be cited
- 17 as the "Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act".
