# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Mail Order Contact Lens Act is amended by 5 changing Section 30 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 83/30)

7 Sec. 30. Violation; civil penalty.

(a) Any person who dispenses, offers to dispense, or 8 9 attempts to dispense contact lenses in violation of this Act or its rules shall, in addition to any other penalty provided by 10 11 law, pay a civil penalty to the the Department in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each offense as determined by the 12 Department. The civil penalty shall be assessed by 13 the 14 Department after a hearing is held in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Illinois Administrative Procedure 15 16 Act.

17 (b) The Department may investigate all violations of this18 Act.

(c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. The order constitutes a judgment and may be filed and execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from any court of record. HB3702
