A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
6 to the State Comptroller to pay the elected State officers of  
7 the Executive Branch of the State Government, at various  
8 rates prescribed by law:

 13 in Sections 5 through 20 of this Act are insufficient and  
 14 other expenses associated with the administration of Sections  
 15 5 through 20.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
 17 2007.
