- 9 Budget Relief Fund.
- Section 10. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the FY09 Budget Relief
- 12 Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
- 13 for the Illinois Rural HealthNet.

Section 15. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as

2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the FY09 Budget Relief

3 Fund to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services for

costs associated with a health information exchange

5 initiative.

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6 ARTICLE 2

7 Section 5. All of the appropriations in this article are

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1 ARTICLE 5

2 Section 5. The amount of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the 3 Tobacco Settlement Recovery Fund to the Department 5 Healthcare and Family Services in order for the department to provide one-time catastrophic relief payments to Illinois 6 based hospitals that have an MIUR greater than the current 7 statewide mean; are not a publicly owned hospital; and are 8 not part of a multiple hospital network, unless such a 9 10 hospital has an MIUR greater than the current statewide mean plus two standard deviations. Payments under this program 11 will be determined by the Department of Healthcare and Family 12 Services. 13

14 ARTICLE 99

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
